This morning you will travel to the legendary **Moncao Monte Carlo**. This sovereign city-state is full of beauty to appreciate, whether it's Monté Carlo's casino or the Palace of the Prince of Monaco, admiring the real estate or the sea views, luxury is everywhere you look.

Upon arrival explore the Old Port Area and the Monte Carlo Palace of Monaco.

The north face, with its caves and cascade, shelters plants from the Mediterranean as well as plants from other humid regions. The garden pathways are dotted with information about Eze's artistic and historical heritage, giving the visitor a real feel for the past of this exceptional site.

The remainder of the evening will be at your leisure in Nice.

The 18 holes (par 72) of the international golf course at Sainte-Maxime are generously spread over 150 acres of beautiful undulating landscape, offering superb views of the Côte d'Azur and across Provence.

Sainte-Maxime golf course was designed by English golf architect Don Harradine, and built in 1991. It commands some of the best views of the spectacular bay of Saint-Tropez, as you wind your way through the intoxicating scent of the wild heather of Provence.

12.00-13.00 Tee start on Championship course. (Walking course with pull buggy provided.) Lunch box included (sandwich/water/fruit).

Gullivers will take active steps to seek to recover funds from suppliers to pass on to the consumer. In addition, Gullivers reserve the right to charge a cancellation fee for administration and other expenses incurred at a cost of no less than \$100.00 per person. As an alternative to cancellation, Gullivers will discuss postponement of travel plans if the consumer wishes to pursue a credit. Where a third party supplier is willing to provide a credit, Gullivers will negotiate for the best possible outcome of credit for any funds held by a third party supplier for future use. **Documentation:** Australian citizens require a passport with minimum 6 months validity from date of departure from final destination.
