
Return to the hotel in the afternoon to relax and freshen up before tonight's first match of the tour!

07.00 Depart Paris for Villers Bretonneux (135 kms - 1 hr 45m). This allows extra time for convenience stop.

On arrival we meet with our local **English speaking expert guide of the Somme Battlefields** for a full-day guided tour of the area.

If we are early, then we can visit the following sites, adjusting to ensure we are departing at 9.45am for Australian Memorial: Adelaide Cemetery (Unknown Soldier), Australia-Franco Museum (Victoria School is next to the museum). You can no longer enter however it is worth telling the story on the coach. Villers Bretonneux has a lot of references to Australia ie street names, flags etc.



09.45	Depart for the Australian Memorial and Sir John Monash Centre . Allow 15 minutes for the memorial and 90 mins for Sir John Monash Centre.
11.45	Depart for Pozières (29 kms - 30 minutes) stopping briefly just to view significant sites eg. 1 st Division monument, windmill.
12.30	Lunch at Le Tommy Cafe and Museum (or similar)
13.20	Depart for Beaumont Hamel (9 kms - 10 mins) to visit Newfoundland Memorial to understand trench warfare.
14.15	Depart for Thiepval Memorial, one of the largest memorials in the world. Unveiled in 1932, it bears the names of more than 72,000 soldiers who went missing during the fighting
15.30	Stop at Lochnagar Crater . The crater displays the effects of using tunnelling and the memorial just show the enormity of human loss.
15.45	Depart for Reims. 154km (2:30hrs)

the next three nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Arrive Reims where you will check into your hotel where you will stay for

This morning you will discover a **local farm** where you will be greeted by a person from the farm and share his passion. You will get to know the life of the local rural world, the trades of the farm and its human and economic activities.

This farm has three main productions transformed on the spot for direct sale: cereals for dry pasta, Salers beef... and, very unusual, myocastor whose flesh is transformed into pâté, rillettes, and a whole range of readymade dishes. Before leaving the farm, you will have the pleasure of **tasting some of their products**.

Return to Reims in the late morning. You will have time to get your own lunch in the city centre.

In the afternoon, discover the city centre of Reims with an English speaking-guide. Touring the sites of Reims on the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites will enable you to discover treasures of inestimable value, symbols of the central place of Reims in History.

In the late afternoon, enjoy a champagne tasting in a prestigious **Maison** de Champagne!



This morning head to the Champagne vineyards.

In the village on Chamery, get on board the "little train of the Champagne vineyards". During this guided tour (available in English), you will discover the work of the vineyard and the know-how of the winegrowers.

You will be dropped off at the winemaker - **Champagne Pascal Lallement** - for a visit of the cellars and a tasting of the Brut 1er Cru.

As a follow-up to the stroll in the vineyard and the visit of the cellar, you will enjoy a **lunch in the cellar room**, with service in traditional Champagne costume!

Return to Reims in the afternoon. Rest of the day is at leisure for your own visits and activities.



THURSDAY 14 SEPTEMBER REIMS / TROYES / MACON

Breakfast at your hotel before checking out.

Board your coach charter leaving for Burgundy.

This morning you will visit a **second farm** near Troyes.

This second farm is a family-run dairy farm. On 120 hectares, the farmers raise 70 dairy cows and 80 heifers for the renewal of the herd. Since 2016, they have been selling their products directly processed on the farm. To the delight of visitors and consumers, the farm controls all stages of production: from feeding the cows (meadows, cereals, corn silage, hay...) to the processed products, including milking the cows. You will have the opportunity to watch the cheese being made (as they do every Thursday morning) and of course you will taste some of their products at the end of your visit.

Transfer to **Dijon** and visit the town, famous for its mustard and the Palace of the Dukes of Burgundy.



Arrival in **Macon** in the evening where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

FRIDAY 15 SEPTEMBER MACON

Breakfast at the hotel.

This morning you will enjoy a **gourmet tour of Mâcon with an English-speaking guide**. You will get to taste local specialties including "croissant", "pâté en croute" (meat pie), "gaufrette" (wafer) and some local wines. The group will be divided into two.

Time will be given for you to enjoy lunch at your leisure.

After lunch you will spend the afternoon visiting a third farm.

Today, you will discover another very original farm. This farm is both a deer farm and a bee farm. During the visit, the farmer will tell you about his two productions. He will talk about subjects as diverse as the making of honey and beeswax candles, the feeding of the animals, the raw materials used on the farm... You will also take a walk in the deer park. Here, too, you can enjoy a tasting before leaving!



Breakfast at your hotel before checking out.

This morning you will leave Macon and before heading for Lyon, discover the **Domaine des Saveurs**, an emblematic cultural site of the region, located in a former agricultural property of more than 40 hectares, with a farm classified as a historic monument.

Arrival in Lyon, in the afternoon where you will stay for the next four nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

As the home of the infamous Little Prince and his creator, Antoine de St. Exupéry, there's a touch of magic in the air in Lyon. Perhaps you'll find it when you walk into one of the world gastronomy capital's numerous restaurants, or when you're exploring the ancient Gaul capital's jaw-dropping Gallo-Roman Ancient Theatre of Fourvière. Maybe it'll be when you're taking in the views of the city from the Fourvière basilica viewpoint or the nearby Parc des Hauteurs, or when you're exploring the French Resistance Museum and the passageways they used to send secret messages. Lyon will charm you.



SUNDAY

17 SEPTEMBER LYON / ST ETIENNE / LYON

Breakfast at your hotel.

Today you will head off to the region of Saint Etienne to visit a **fourth farm**

This one is a **modern and innovative milk farm** focused on organic farming and renewable energies. Photovoltaic energy is used, for example, to dry the hay. During the visit, the farmer will explain his production methods and the operation of his milking robots.

You will enjoy lunch on site.

In the afternoon transfer to Stade Geoffroy Guichard for your third Rugby World Cup fixture of the tour: Australia vs Fiji.

Kick off

17:45

RWC 2023: Australia v Fiji, Stade Geoffroy Guichard, Saint Étienne.

After the match, transfer back to your hotel by coach.

This morning you will enjoy a **walking guided tour in old Lyon**. The esplanade of Fourvière offers a magnificent uninterrupted view of Lyon. The basilica of Notre Dame, built at the end of the 19th century, is a real eye-catcher. Your walk then takes you down towards Old Lyon, either through the Rosaire gardens or via the Roman theatres. Do not forget that Lugdunum was founded on the hill of Fourvière in 43 BC. At the bottom of the hill, the Renaissance town stretches out along the banks of the river Saone. Walk through a few of the narrow streets and the squares and delve into the "traboules" to discover hidden courtyards, galleries and wells...

A group lunch will be served in Lyon at "Bouchon Lyonnais" (3 course menu drinks not included).

In the afternoon, you will leave the bustle of the city center and will be greeted by a farmer who will open the doors of his farm.

Today you will visit a family farm which has diversified over the years around the following activities: sheep and poultry breeding, cultivation, eco-pasturing and transhumance, reception of the public and direct sales of products. Chickens, ducks, geese, guinea fowl, turkeys and lambs are raised. The farm grows cereals (wheat, barley and triticale), which are mainly used to feed the poultry and sheep, but also a few vines and cherry trees. A tasting will conclude the visit.

After visiting the farm, you may wish to visit the **wine cooperative** where local farmers sell their produce, and which now has 350 winegrowers in the heart of the Beaujolais vineyard.

TUESDAY 19 SEPTEMBER LYON

B/L

Breakfast at your hotel.

This morning you will visit a **sixth farm** in the region of Lyon.

The farm that you visit today is a cattle farm in the Monts du Lyonnais in search of a balanced production method: soil-plant-animal-man. The herd of Aubrac cows graze most of the year. The organic fodder is produced on the farm, respecting the life of the soil and the surrounding hedges. From the farm to the consumer, all the beef is processed on the farm and delivered directly to the consumer. Its traceability guaranteed!

After the visit you will share a **convivial time around a farm burger** made with meat from the farm.

You then return to Lyon. This afternoon visit Paul Bocuse Covered Market ("Halles Bocuse") with an English-speaking guide. After learning a little about Lyon gastronomy, go for a stroll through the alleyways of the covered market and discover all the products that make the world capital of gastronomy so famous. A festival of colour, sound, aroma and taste in a very special atmosphere. A tasting session of regional products will close the visit.

Breakfast at your hotel before checkout.

Today you will depart for the south of France and the Var region.

On the way you will stop in Avignon to enjoy a lunch on your own and have time to stroll in the city.



Arrive in Toulon where you will stay for the next three nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Today you are going on the Provence wine route. Famous all over the world, especially for their rosé wine. Amidst pines, olive trees, lavender fields and sometimes, just a few meters from the Mediterranean, the region's vineyards have a good life. **Explore two different vineyards with wine tasting**.

The first estate covers twenty-one hectares of vines, which are managed with a genuine respect for the ecosystem, the fauna and the flora. The vineyard is inspired by the fundamental principles of biodynamics. These approaches and the deep convictions of the winegrowers naturally give rise to generous wines, with a beautiful minerality worthy of the greatest terroirs.

A buffet group lunch has been organized at the vineyard (wines of the estate are included).

In the afternoon, visit a second wine estate.

During a stroll through the heart of the estate, you will discover the secret of Bandol wines, the barrel room and the wine-making facilities, from the grape harvest reception cellar to the ageing cellar. Your tour will end in the cellar with a tasting of Bandol appellation wines.

Before arriving enjoy a friendly moment around a **cocktail in a local rugby club.**

Arrival in Lyon where you will stay for the next 2 nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

This morning you may like to visit Lyon's Musée Miniature et Cinéma in the heart of Vieux Lyon (Lyon's old town). This museum unites miniaturist and founder Dan Ohlmann's two passions: the magic of film special effects and the art of miniatures! (admission not included)


