

You'll see the handsome houses constructed by wealthy merchants and garrison officers when you walk through the Rue de Doux area, and you'll pass the 14th-century church and the oldest secondary school in France.



Gullivers will take active steps to seek to recover funds from suppliers to pass on to the consumer. In addition, Gullivers reserve the right to charge a cancellation fee for administration and other expenses incurred at a cost of no less than \$100.00 per person. As an alternative to cancellation, Gullivers will discuss postponement of travel plans if the consumer wishes to pursue a credit. Where a third party supplier is willing to provide a credit, Gullivers will negotiate for the best possible outcome of credit for any funds held by a third party supplier for future use. **Documentation:** Australian citizens require a passport with minimum 6 months validity from date of departure from final destination, and a current vaccination record or report in accord with the current government or third party supplier conditions. For international travel booking, Gullivers will assume that all travellers on the booking have a valid Australian passport which is valid for the relevant destination and transit point. If this is not the case, you must let us know. Other passport holders may require additional documentation.
