THURSDAY 21 SEPTEMBER LYON

Arrival into Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport, France.

You will be met at the airport by your English_speaking professional tour manager who will accompany you for the duration of the tour.

Transfer to your four-star centrally located Lyon hotel where you will stay for the next four nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Commanding a strategic spot at the confluence of the Rhône and the Saône Rivers, Lyon has been luring people ever since the Romans named it Lugdunum in 43 BC. Outstanding museums, a dynamic cultural life, a thriving university and fantastic shopping lend the city a distinctly sophisticated air, while adventurous gourmets can indulge in their wildest gastronomic fantasies.



This evening, enjoy a **welcome drink & canapés** with your touring party at the hotel.

FRIDAY 22 SEPTEMBER LYON

Breakfast at your hotel.

Today is at your leisure to explore Lyon.

On your days of leisure, your local tour manager will be on hand for any information you require or to offer sightseeing suggestions.

Today there will be a half day walking tour in Old Town Lyon, a cobblestoned crossroads between tourist hotspot and local hangout! Old Lyon has UNESCO status and lots of bars where locals hang out, along with plenty of shops and art galleries. As you wander the neighbourhood, you will see Lyon's famous one-of-a-kind Traboules: passageways that were used by both city-dwellers over 1,500 years ago and the French Resistance during World War II, and many in between.

You will then ascend by funicular to the Fourvière Basilica. The **Basilica Notre-Dame of Fourvière** is the work of the architects Pierre Bossan and Sainte-Marie Perrin. It was built thanks to a public subscription in 1872. The basilica is at the top of "the hill which prays" and is dedicated to the Virgin Mary.

Conclude your morning with a cruise down the Rhône River.



Lyon is renowned for being one of the gastronomic capitals of the world. Immerse yourself in the flavours and enjoy **dinner in a bouchon**, a restaurant that is native to Lyon.

SUNDAY 24 SEPTEMBER LYON

This morning is at your leisure in Lyon.

This evening you will transfer by coach to OL Stadium, Lyon to see your first RWC 2023 pool match of the tour, Wales v Australia.

Kick off 21:00 RWC 2023 Wales v Australia

After the match, transfer back to your hotel by coach.

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today you will travel by coach from Lyon to Annecy, via Aix-les-bains. There will be a guided tour of **Aix-les-bains**, which is renowned as a thermal station with its beautiful lake and its unique charm of old mountains towns. Spend your afternoon on a cruise on the beautiful **Bourget Lake** and learn about the history of the region. See the mountains that hug the city and the impressive **Hautecombe's Abbey**.

Continue onto Annecy where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.



Nestled by the north-western shore of its namesake Lake Annecy is the jewel of the Haute-Savoie. From its crowning Château d'Annecy down to its gurgling canals. Annecy is known for its Vieille Ville (old town), with cobbled streets, winding canals and pastel-coloured houses.

Chamonix is a vibrant town known as both a world-class ski resort and a mountaineering destination. Besides skiing, Chamonix is one of the best places to visit in France for hiking, rock climbing, paragliding, golf, and tennis. It is also worth the journey just to breathe in the fresh Alpine air, soak up the inspiring scenery, and listen to the sound of rushing streams.

THURSDAY 28 SEPTEMBER CHAMONIX

This morning will start with a round trip on the **Montée d'Aiguille cable car.** The Aiguille du Midi is a 3842m peak in the Mont Blanc massif of the French Alps, giving way to a panoramic view of the spectacular Alps – and not just the French Alps, but the Swiss and Italian Alps as well! This is the closest you can get to the summit of Mont-Blanc without hiking or climbing.



Enjoy a trip on the **Montenvers train route**, which will allow you to see **la Mer de Glace**, a glacial alpine village and even an ice cave.

After lunch continue to Sarlat La Canéda. Upon arrival check into your hotel where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.



Boasting some of the region's best-preserved medieval architecture, Sarlat-la- Canéda medieval old town is the perfect place to wander around with its maze of picturesque narrow streets and Gothic and Renaissance mansions. Its central Sainte-Marie Church hosts an indoor food market, and a glass elevator in the bell tower offers city views. Sarlat Market sells local delicacies like foie gras and cheese.

Today there will be a full day tour of the **Dordogne Valley's Golden Triangle**. The Golden Triangle is made up of the most beautiful villages in France; the royal fortified town of **Domme**, the picturesque Roque-**Gagaec** and **Beynac** with its fortified castle.

Today there will be a group lunch in a typical restaurant of the region.

After lunch head down the **Dordogne River** and hop aboard a traditional wooden boat, a **gabares**, for an old-fashioned river cruise.

At the end of your cruise return to Sarlat where the remainder of the evening will be at your leisure.

Breakfast at the hotel.

This morning travel by coach to **Saint-Emilion**, one of the world's most reputable wine regions! (It was even the first in the world to get UNESCO status, so it's more than worth the stop!)

Enjoy a tasting and a tour with a local producer. You will see many parts of the property, including the wine production area and the vines themselves.

Enjoy a 3-course lunch in the wine region before continuing to Bordeaux.

Upon arrival into Bordeaux check into your centrally located hotel where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

There are many reasons to visit the gorgeous city of Bordeaux – walks along the winding Garonne River, superbly grand architecture and a decadent gourmet scene where freshly shucked oysters and succulent steaks take centre stage. But one particular attraction will always reign supreme: wine. Bordeaux is often held up as the gold standard of winemaking and it's easy to see why. The Bordelais take their reputation very seriously.

Today is at your leisure to explore Bordeaux.

06 OCTOBER

Today you will travel by coach to Biarritz.

Upon arrival to **Biarritz**, you will check into your hotel where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

The celebrated seaside resort of Biarritz is synonymous with elegance and upper-class style. Biarritz has everything it takes to get your heart racing, from legendary beaches that draw surfers from around the world to picturesque mountain villages. This subtle blend of contemporary style and authentic Basque tradition promises an amazing experience.

SATURDAY 07 OCTOBER BIARRITZ / SAN SEBASTIAN / BIARRITZ

Today you will travel to **San Sebastian** where you will have time at leisure to explore the city. This coastal city in **Spanish Basque Country** is small, but dense with a variety of things to see and do.

San Sebastián has undeniable allure, from its venerable dining scene to its grand architecture, framed by golden beaches and lush hillsides. It's known for **Playa de la Concha** and **Playa de Ondarreta**, beaches framed by a picturesque bayfront promenade, and world-renowned restaurants helmed by innovative chefs. In its cobblestoned old town (Parte Vieja), upscale shops neighbour vibrant pintxo bars pairing local wines with bite-size regional specialties.

Today there will be a group lunch in a traditional restaurant.

This afternoon board your coach and return to Biarritz, where the remainder of the afternoon and evening will be at your leisure.

08 OCTOBER

Breakfast at the hotel.

This morning travel via coach to **Lourdes** where you will have free time to explore the city.

The second most important Catholic pilgrimage site in the world after Rome, Lourdes was made famous by the apparitions of the Virgin Mary to Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. Today, the sanctuaries of Lourdes, located on the banks of the Gave de Pau, attract millions of visitors and pilgrims each year. The esplanade of the Rosary - dominated by the neo-Byzantine style Basilica of Our Lady, the crypt and the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the famous Miraculous Grotto where the Virgin Mary appeared 18 times, the underground Basilica of Saint Pius X, the Way of the Cross with its 15 stations are among the highlights of the religious city. A place with a very special spiritual and mystical atmosphere.

Continue onto **Toulouse** where you will stay for the next two nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Ochre rooftops and blushing brick churches earned Toulouse the nickname 'La Ville Rose' (**The Pink City**). Its enchanting Vieux Quartier (Old Quarter) is a dreamy jumble of coral-coloured shopfronts and churches. Beyond the old town, Toulouse sprawls into France's fourth-largest metropolis. It is an animated, hectic place, but Toulouse – nestled between a bend in the Garonne River and the mighty Canal du Midi – is invigorated by its waterways.



This afternoon you will travel by coach to Stadium de Toulouse.

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today you will explore the villages in Toulouse's surrounding area.

After lunch at a local restaurant continue onto **Avignon.** Here you will stay for the next three nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

For 70-odd years of the early 1300s, the Provençal town of Avignon was the centre of the Roman Catholic world, and though its stint as the seat of papal power only lasted a few decades, it has been left with an impressive legacy of ecclesiastical architecture, most notably the soaring, World Heritage-listed fortress-cum-palace known as the Palais des Papes.

This evening is at your leisure in Avignon.

Today there will be a guided walking tour of Avignon. Discover the charming city including the **Popes Palace** and the **Pont d'Avignon**.


Visit and taste some very famous wine from the region, with a local winemaker, including lunch.

Today you will travel by coach from Avignon to Marseille.

On your way you will stop at a **local Rugby club** in Aix-Marseille. You will be warmly received by rugby officials, enjoy tastings and lunch in the company of the club's players and learn about French rugby traditions.



Rouen is home to a collection of impressive **Gothic cathedrals.** Enjoy a guided walking tour exploring the town.

Continue on to **Côte Fleurie** (Flowery Coast) where you will have time at leisure to explore Honfleur and Deauville.

In **Honfleur**, rock the port vibe and take in many of the picturesque scenes that inspired the impressionist painters.



Deauville, otherwise known as "the Hamptons for Parisians", is a beach town. Deauville's signature brightly coloured striped beach cabins on the beloved boardwalk, **la Promenade des Planches**, will lighten up even the rainiest of days.

This afternoon continue by coach to **Caen**. Upon arrival check into your centrally located hotel where you will stay for the next three nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

With its superb collection of restaurants, atmospheric streets and manageable size, Caen is a terrific place to explore. The easy-going city is also a launchpad to the nearby D-Day sights spread out along the coast. Founded by William the Conqueror in the 11th century, Caen – capital of the Basse Normandie region – was massively damaged during the 1944 Battle of Normandy, but considerable history and heritage survives to make it a very good-looking city.

Today there will be a full day tour visiting the **Mémorial de Caen Museum** and the **D-Day landing beaches**, Omaha Beach and Pointe du Hoc.

These sites are an incredible opportunity to see first-hand the sites that played a key role in ending World War II. You will learn about the events of D-Day as well as how they fit into a larger historical context, the details of the arrival of the Allied troops, the sacrifices made by the Norman people and much more.

Today there will be a full day coach tour to **Bayeux** and the very famous **Mont Saint-Michel.**

Start the morning visiting the **Bayeux Tapestry**.

It has spent seven centuries in the Treasury of Bayeux cathedral and was then moved to a number of different locations in the city and throughout France before ending its journey in the former Seminary of Bayeux, where it has been on display since 1983. Since then, it has continued to be a never-ending source of inspiration for scientists and artists all over the world.

Continue onto **Mont Saint-Michel**, one of the most visited places in France. During your visit you can admire the atypical geography, depending on the tide Mont Saint-Michel alternates between island and mainland. You will also visit the **abbey**, a splendid example of medieval architecture in the area perched atop the mount that gives you spectacular views of the bays that surround the mount.



This afternoon return to Caen where the remainder of the evening is at your leisure.

Today you will travel by coach to the Loire Valley.

Visit the famous castle of **Chenonceau**. An architectural masterpiece, property of the Crown and then a royal residence, **Château de Chenonceau** is a truly exceptional site by its original design, but also its history. Loved, managed and protected by women, including Diane of Poitiers and Catherine de Medicis, it is also known as the **'Château des Dames'**. The feminine touch is everywhere; it has protected the Château from the ravages of war and made it a peaceful place.

Today there will be lunch at *L'Orangerie*, a gourmet restaurant at Château de Chenonceau.



Continue onto Tours to check into your centrally located hotel. Here you will stay overnight on a bed and breakfast basis.

Tours stands on the lower reaches of the Loire River. A former Caesarodunum city of the Turones, it possesses one of the largest amphitheatres of the Roman Empire.

This morning there will be a guided tour of Chambord Castle. The **Château de Chambord** is one of the most recognisable châteaux in the world because of its very distinctive French Renaissance architecture which blends traditional French medieval forms with classical Renaissance structures.



After your tour of the castle there will be a group lunch in Chambord.


